**Training Course Title: Energy Code Overview and Plan Review Basics for Energy Code**

A building doesn't just appear. It starts with the design of the building and ends with it being inspected. What provisions are found in the IECC that should be provided on the plans and what should we be looking for when reviewing a project to get the desired results in the field for energy compliance?
